Basic Life Support (BLS) is the foundation for all health care providers in saving lives after cardiac arrest. BLS refers to the care, all healthcare providers, provide to patients who are experiencing respiratory arrest, cardiac arrest or airway obstruction. Survival rates for an unconscious individual are increased by up to 60 percent through prompt resuscitation. BLS includes psychomotor skills for performing high-quality cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), using an automated external defibrillator (AED) and relieving an obstructed airway for patients of all ages. Rapid response to emergency situations can save lives, making life support training critically important for healthcare personnel. BLS providers should also have skills on Critical thinking, Problem solving, Communication, and Team dynamics. With BLS training, the individual feels secure with the knowledge gained to take the right actions needed to save a life. Additionally, this confidence will empower an individual to take control of the situation and direct any bystanders as needed. Calling for emergency assistance is one of the ways that bystanders can be instructed to assist during emergencies. All health providers need to be equipped with adequate knowledge and skills to save individuals who are critical. It is essential to integrate and coordinate all these skills to achieve the common goal, reviving the arrested victims.

We the health team members (C.S.I. St.Luke's College of Nursing) wish to equip our junior health care providers towards Basic Life Support through the state level workshop on "Basic Life Support: Learn to save Lives" which will be held at Multipurpose hall, C.S.I. St.Luke's College of Nursing, Nazareth on 9th May, 2018 from 7.30 am to 5.30 p.m.

The aim of this workshop is to equip the participants with current knowledge and skills on basic life support to provide effective and excellent immediate care to the victims with life threatening conditions in the hospital and in the community.
